Finance section of college is headed by Accountant from Finance dept. who is assisted by Junior Assistant and helper. He strictly follows the codal procedure before releasing payment in favour of any vendor. E governance procedures like BEAMS, Disbursement of Salaries etc through DBT etc.

Admission granted to students on first come first basis in most of cases with minimum eligibility as reflected in university statutes. However in subjects like IT, Biotechnology, Bioinformatics, BCA, IFF, BBA the candidates are admitted on merit basis or through entrance exam conducted by college. All admission and support system carried out is fully implemented in the form of online admission system. The attendance of all the students in all the semesters is updated and monitored through CAMES 1.2 (College Attendance Monitoring and Evaluation System). It is pertinent to mention that the said systems for Admissions and Attendance have been developed by the Computer Science Department of the College.

All the Even Semester examinations conducted through OMR and subsequently Softwares based evaluations are carried out resulting into the speedy declaration of the results.

2. Skill development Promotion of Entrepreneurship:

Govt. Degree College, Baramulla believes in holistic development of its students with a major focus on skill development. College envisions skill development as its primary responsibility towards equipping its students with minimum skill-set required for employability. In this direction linkage has been developed with industrial training partners like CIIT-Baramulla, NIELIT Srinagar, Islamic University of Science & Technology, IMHANS and several Departments of J&K Government like Agriculture, Horticulture, and Fisheries. To carry forward this mission around 250 students were trained during 2021 & 2022 in various NSQF aligned skills courses like IoT, Web Designing, CCC, Mushroom Cultivation, Cocoon Rearing etc. College encourages its students to adopt the “earn while you learn” policy. In this direction a number of students have been trained in Mushroom Cultivation, saffron cultivation and vermicomposting. Some of the trainees have also established startups in their localities and are generating a handsome income.

As NEP-2020 emphasizes the importance of outcome-based education as a way to ensure that students acquire the knowledge, skills, and competencies they need to succeed in the 21st century, syllabi of all programmes/courses being offered have been designed by the concerned BOS-Board of Studies in line with industry demand. Moreover, course outcomes are clearly highlighted in the course structure of almost all the academic programmes. Besides, College has launched a basket of (3+1)-credit skill courses and in view of NEP recommendations, several skill centers have been established under Hub & Spoke Model through liberal funding under Capex budget.
