

Visit to Migrant Pandit Colony at Baramulla



As part of Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) and Community Outreach Programme, IQAC team of the college and NSS Programme Officers under chairmanship of worthy Principal visited Migrant Pandit Colony at Veervan village of Baramulla on 30th June 2021. The aim of the visit was to express solidarity and convey message of National Integration and communal harmony with Pandit community, whom state Govt. has housed in a colony on the banks of river Jhelum along National Highway Road.

The team from college was accorded warm and affectionate welcome by members of Pandit community. After introduction and interaction both sides exchanged views and put forth the purpose of visit to this colony.

The Principal of the college Prof.(Dr.)M.A.Lone at the outset informed the members of the community about the aim of visit like providing of institutional support in academics to their wards, counselling facility and sports facility for their children.

The community projected following issues before the college authorities, which the Principal endorsed in full letter and spirit. The issues and demands of the community were.

- 1) Sports kits/items for children of Pandit family preferably for under 19 school going children.
- 2) Volley ball and badminton court facility be created within migrant colony to enable inmates to entertain and get relieved from stress.
- 3) Extension and guest lectures for children.
- 4) Art and drawing kits and some stationery items for their kids.
- 5) Conduct of Remedial classes for children of migrant family members.

After thread bare discussion, the Principal invited the members of Pandit Colony to have look of the college in near future and avail facilities like library and Browsing centre facility, Psychological and Carrier counselling facility and any other services which they may find relevant.
