1. Conducted Board of Studies (BoS) meetings - Framing & Revision of Syllabi

To implement NEP-2020 effectively, the College conducted BoS meetings for all subjects under its autonomous mandate. Each department constituted its BoS and revised/developed syllabi following the UGC draft guidelines. These syllabi cover Major, Minor, Multi-Disciplinary, Value Added and Skill Enhancement courses. The College invited renowned academics and practitioners from diverse fields to collaborate in syllabus framing emphasising on Outcome-Based Education. The redesigned syllabi and courses were renamed to reflect the NEP-2020 provisions, which also prioritize the integration of Indian Knowledge Systems.

2. An Excellence towards Academic Bank of Credit (ABC)

The college has made significant progress in implementing ABC. In the 2023-24 the college successfully completed the registration of students from the Batches of 2022 and 2023 on the ABC platform.

The convener National Academic Depository (NAD) ensures the accurate collection and verification of student data and providing assistance with registrations.

The college organized various awareness and training programs for faculty and students on the effective use of the ABC platform, highlighting college's commitment to modernizing education and enhancing student opportunities in a multidisciplinary academic environment.
